**Break new ground with the largest grant opportunity in the history of the California Arts Council**

Innovations + Intersections grants will serve as a resource for nonprofit arts organizations statewide to implement creative strategies that take on urgent community needs crossing the **technology** and/or **health** sectors.

- Focus areas: arts and wellness, arts and technology
- Grants up to \$500,000 for three-year projects
- Open to communities and organizations of all sizes
- No funding match required
- Two-step application process

## WHO CAN APPLY

- Arts organizations  
*Nonprofit or 501(c)(3)  
fiscal sponsor*
- Arts-based units of government or tribal government

California organizations only.  
Two-year minimum history of arts programming required.  
Program-specific eligibility found in grant guidelines.
