2. Promote economic development through the arts
3. Enhance arts and cultural education



Arts Master Plan 2035: Vision and Action

The City Council adopted the City’s first 10-year Arts Master Plan in March 2016. The 2016 plan identified 41 recommendations across 10 thematic categories, adding 20 recommendations in a 2022 update. Over the last 10 years, 54 of these recommendations have been successfully addressed, while four remain in the early stages of development and three have been deferred from current priority lists.

To assist in developing the next 10-year Arts Master Plan, the City hired Keen Independent Research to evaluate the City’s progress, collect community feedback, and assist staff in developing new action items. The new Arts Master Plan 2035: Vision and Action outlines 16 recommendations across five thematic categories. The thematic elements are:

1. **Cultivate the Arts Throughout Santa Clarita**
2. **Serve as a Cross-Pollinator of Community Arts Efforts**
3. **Support Artists and Arts Nonprofits**
4. **Review Arts Governance, Policies, and Procedures**
5. **Plan for Arts Venues, Spaces, and Resources**

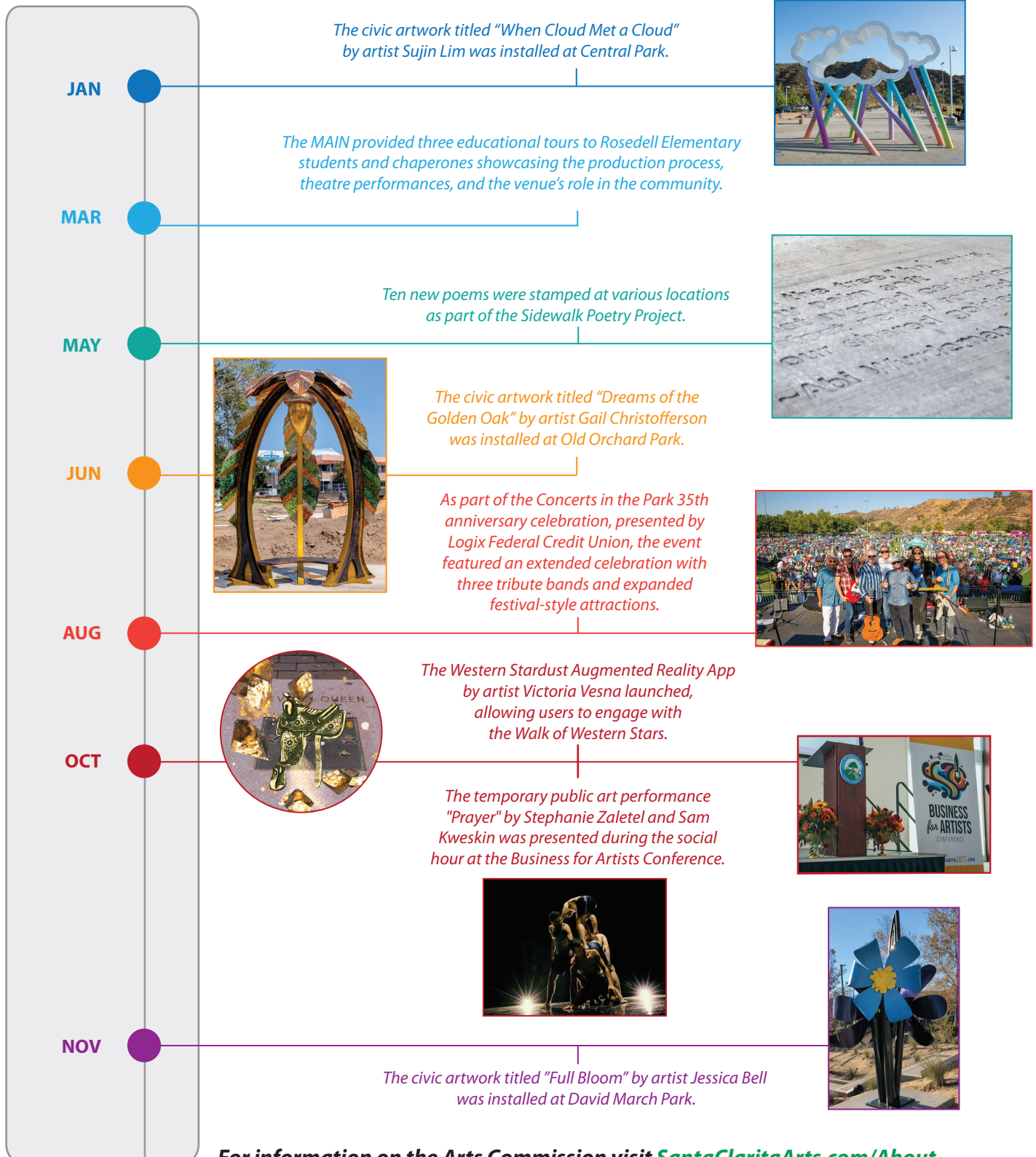
